Completion Grants

- Application: Every October
- PhD year: Final phase

Mobility Grants

- Once: Host laboratory visit
- Application: Deadlines are
 - 15 October
 - 15 January
 - 15 April
 - 15 July
- PhD year: All

Travel Grants

- One grant/year: Present at a conference or attend a summer/winter school.
- Application: On a rolling basis, but no later than two months before the event.
- PhD year: All

Completion Grants

- Application: Every April
- PhD year: Final phase

Important notes on grants!

You need to fulfil requirements as follows:

- be a PhaNuSpo member,
- FÖP within 12 months,
- approved doctoral thesis agreement after the approved FÖP within one month, and
- thereafter, approved annual progress reports and TAC meeting minutes. TAC minutes are obligatory for PhD candidates who started on or after 01/03/2024.

- PhD year: All

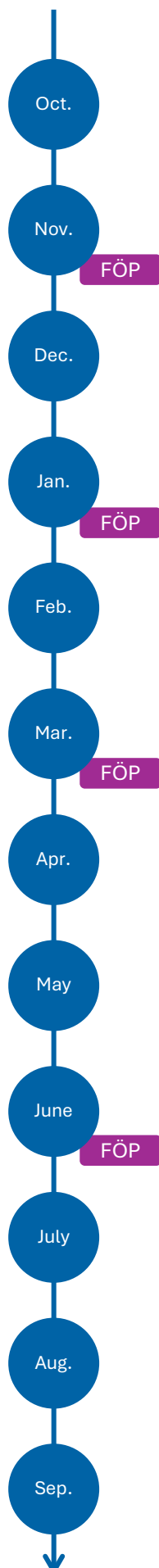
Effective Visual Communication of Science

- 1 ECTS

- 1 ECTS
- PhD year: 1

Modules 2 and 4: Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR)

- Every October
- The modules must be completed in sequence
- Format: Each module combined blended learning with a half-day in-person workshop.
- 0,25 ECTS / Module
- PhD year: 2 (M2) + 3 (M4)

Research Data Management (RDM)

- Summer semester: Every March and June
- Format: Two on-site half-days and preps (~20 hours in total)
- Your opportunity: Receive feedback on your DMP when submitting it for FÖP registration.
- 1 ECTS
- PhD year: 1

Modules 1 and 3: Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR)

- Every April or May
- Format: Each module combined blended learning with a half-day in-person workshop.
- 0,25 ECTS / Module
- PhD year: 1 (M1) + 2 (M3)

Note: External achievements

ECTS credits are awarded for presenting research at international conferences and summer schools, hosting laboratory visits, and undertaking training at other universities and educational organisations. Credits are also awarded for the co-supervision of Master's students. The way in which transferable skills courses and conferences are recognised varies according to the curricula.
